

School-wide Remote Learning

Ways to use ClassDojo for remote learning...but the sky's the limit!



Read-a-louds. Record a video of you reading for students and families to watch from home.



Daily schedule. Send families a photo of your daily schedule, so they can maintain consistency at home.



Check-ins. Reach out to families individually via Messaging to see how they're doing.



Digital meetups. Create an event on Class Story and include a link to Zoom or Google Hangouts.



Physical challenges. Post a video doing push-ups or jumping jacks and challenge students to beat you!



Choice boards. Post Bingo cards with ideas like “upload a room tour” and “write a personal narrative story”



Activities. Create activities that students can respond to on their Portfolio, like a video book review.



Daily journal. Encourage students to document their days during this new adventure of remote learning.



Post PDFs and learning links. Provide families with resources to help students continue practicing skills.



Social emotional learning. Share the Big Ideas videos with families and assign discussion questions as activities.
